Jeanie enjoyed working in her yard crocheting, spending time with her family , most of all working on her family genealogy.

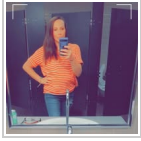

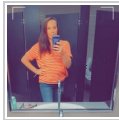
